From a letter to the Provincial written on November 20, 1927:

Most Venerable Father Provincial,

Thank you very much for your words from London. I should have answered sooner, but it has become too difficult for me, not because I feel worse, but because of the request from Maryland. I'm allowed to write about it openly. I have never counted on such a possibility and cannot give my consent. I would have to cheat myself then. I thought it would not be possible because of my health. However, it also seems wrong for me to go to the mission. If you do not have a profession for it, if there is no other way to recovery, then I would have to see the hand of God in it and would do it, if there is no other way. At least I ask your Reverence not to decide now. If the doctor forbids me to do schoolwork at Christmas, there is still time. So far, I've always been inclined to school because I've always had a love of education. If I recover completly, then I would like to ask again for a job in Vallendar.
